#### **DETERMINING WHICH PLAN IS RIGHT FOR YOU:**

Step 1: Which plan do I qualify for based on my household income?

### Step 2: Do I qualify for an insurance plan based on my citizenship or immigration status?

**Medicaid**: Only US citizens or "qualified" immigrants may apply (you must have documented legal status AND most adults will not qualify until you have had that legal status for five years)

**Obamacare**: Only US citizens or "qualified" immigrants may apply (you must have documented legal status in the US but there is no waiting period)

\*If you do not qualify for health insurance, please see page 3 for a list of places where you can go regardless of your immigration status or health insurance.

**NOTE:** Each program may have additional requirements

### **APPLYING FOR MEDICAID:**

**ONLINE:** COMPASS is the name of the website where you can apply for Medical Assistance and many other services like SNAP (food stamps) and cash assistance. You can access that application here: https://www.compass.state.pa.us/Compass.Web/Public/CMPHome

IN PERSON: you can apply at your local County Assistance Office

**WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY:** birth certificates, social security cards, proof of income for the last 30 days, proof of residence (ex- utility bill), ID, last 3 months of medical bills.

Make sure to save any receipts/printouts/paperwork you have to prove that you applied and to prove the date that you applied!

### **APPLYING FOR OBAMACARE:**

Most people must apply for Obamacare or renew their Obamacare coverage during a certain time period called open enrollment.

OPEN ENROLLMENT DEADLINES HAVE CHANGED. **MOST PEOPLE MUST APPLY OR RENEW BETWEEN NOVEMBER 1, 2017-DECEMBER 15, 2017** 

**ONLINE:** You can shop for individual health plans on *Healthcare.gov* 

- Site will be shut down every Sunday of open enrollment from 12am-12pm except on December 10, 2017.
- You can also apply directly through an insurer's website

**BY TELEPHONE:** call the marketplace call center at *1-800-318-2596*

### What if I only qualify for Obamacare but I missed the open enrollment?

You may be able to apply outside of the open enrollment period if: your household size changed (ex- you got married, had a baby, a child turned 26) or you lost your health insurance from another source (your job, a family member, Medicaid, etc).


