## SN Visits: 1 – 2 visits for skilled observation, teaching and training:

- Perform physical assessment of patient
- Observe parenting behavior
- Assess for signs and symptoms of dehydration
- Assess for signs and symptoms of hyperbilirubinemia
- Notify doctor of any significant clinical findings

## SN Goals:

- Parent/caregiver will verbalize knowledge of signs and symptoms of neonatal complications and neonatal care
- Normal physical assessment of baby
- Discharge plan is to follow up with physician

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
