

Graduation from CPC:

If a patient has had no social work or care coordination needs beyond that of an average patient for at least one year AND the child is in a stable permanent placement (for example, at least a year into adoption), consider offering discharge from CPC with continuation of visits with primary provider in primary care clinic.

- Share with families the best way to keep in touch with you.
- Clearly document in your note that child is no longer in CPC
- Remove the CPC flag from the chart
- Put the patient in the appropriate “Follow-up” list and write in the notes for the patient to be scheduled on primary panels and specific provider.

For example: “Schedule for WCC with Taylor PRIMARY PANEL, NOT CPC”

If a family refuses discharge from CPC, continue to see in CPC. You can offer discharge at upcoming visits.
